Call for Papers: Submission are welcome from academics, graduate students, and government officials to present contemporary research and studies relevant to sport, culture and society. Papers may focus on specific projects and locations, as well as cross-national, intercultural or pan-regional contexts. Each proposal should clearly state title, proposer's institutional (or other) affiliation, full contact details and 3-5 keywords and a 200-word abstract, indicating which of the conference themes this paper will address. We are welcome submission of full text of the paper for the TSSS journal - East Asian Sport Thoughts (EAST).

Note: Due to the tight schedule of the conference, the number of accepted papers is limited. Early, quality submissions will be favorably regarded. All proposals will be peer-reviewed. Abstract must be submitted before **1 Sep 2010**. Acceptance of paper will be notified on or before **13 Sep 2010**. Submission of the paper for the EAST at the day of **24 Sep 2010**.

- 13 September 2010 - notice of acceptance
- 20 September 2010 - registration, payment and confirmation of accommodation
